FAMIS and FAMIS Plus https://www.coverva.org/famis/

FAMIS is Virginia's health insurance program for children. It provides access to quality health services for children who do not have health insurance. FAMIS Plus is Virginia's name for children's Medicaid. FAMIS Plus also provides great benefits and covers children in families with low or no income, even if the children are covered by health insurance.

A child must be under 19 and usually be a US citizen or lawfully residing immigrant to be covered by these programs but a parent's citizenship is not considered. Immigrant families with enrolled children will not be labeled a public charge. Receiving FAMIS or FAMIS Plus will not affect a families' ability to obtain U.S. citizenship.

When you apply for coverage, your children will be considered for both FAMIS and FAMIS Plus. The first program your child is evaluated for is FAMIS Plus (formerly Medicaid) through the Department of Family Services: 703-324-3000

The Medical Care for Children Partnership (MCCP)

MCCP is a program of the Fairfax County Department of Family Services, administered by the Health Access Assistance Team (HAAT) under the Self-Sufficiency division, and is a collaboration between Fairfax County Government and the medical and business communities. The Medical Care for Children Partnership (MCCP) offers families with low income (under 250% of FPL) a reduced-cost healthcare program for children under age 18.

MCCP children are enrolled in a medical home with access to regular check-ups, physicals, sick child visits, pharmacy, x-rays and lab work. Enrolled children also receive limited services for specialty care and dental care. Hospitalization and emergency room visits are not covered by the program. MCCP is not health insurance.

They serve children who are from birth to 18 years of age who live in Fairfax County when they do not qualify for FAMIS Plus or FAMIS, do not have affordable health insurance through an employer, and cannot pay for doctor visits or medicine for your children. The clinic accepts most insurances, EXCEPT Kaiser and Tri-Care. If you are uninsured and meet our financial requirements, you may be eligible for charity coverage. Please ask our staff for more information. The center is staffed with pediatricians and nurse practitioners. Services currently include newborn care, immunizations, sick care, and limited well-child care. Walkin clinics are not currently available. Hours are: Monday-Wednesday 9am – 8pm Thursday 9am – 5pm Friday 9am – 4:30pm Saturday 9am – noon Sick visits only
