The Adult Dental Program (ADP) provides low-income, dental-uninsured adults in Fairfax County with assistance in finding a dental home for services at a reduced cost. Clients who are interested in getting access to a private dentist in the community with some financial assistance for their evaluation, cleaning and/or treatment can be from any location in Fairfax County. Clients who are interested in getting a referral to Northern Virginia Dental Clinic can be from any location in Fairfax County.

Requirements: Household income 200% or 250% or less of FPL depending on program, verifiable home address in county of application, no dental insurance, and 18 years or older

For assistance, contact the program directly at 571-748-2593 (intake line is open Mondays and Wednesdays from 9am-12pm).

Medicaid – DentaQuest – Effective 7/1/21, Adults with Medicaid have Dental Coverage including:

Cleanings and preventive care, X-Rays and exams, Fillings, Dentures, Root canals, Gum-related treatment, and Oral surgeries. Contact a DentaQuest representative at 1-888-912-3456 to find a dentist and learn more about the new dental benefit. Transportation services are available to Medicaid members for their dentist appointments.

Payment is based on a sliding scale according to income, marital status, number of children and dependents.

The Northern Virginia Dental Clinic (NVDC) accepts only those individuals deemed eligible through an established network of referring social service agencies based on where they live. Individuals must be age 18 or older with an individual/family income at or below 200% of the federal poverty guidelines.
